PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

At Sarratt Ducklings we take the opportunity to photograph the children during sessions, at work and play and on special occasions e.g. sports day, Christmas party, etc. We then display some of these photographs on the wall in the cloakroom.

The children enjoy being able to find photographs of themselves and take pride in pointing them out to their parents.

We never identify any of the children by name in our displays.

Every parent has the right to refuse permission for their child to be photographed in this way (section on the Keyworker Scheme form). If you do not wish your child to be photographed, please speak to the Group Leader, who will note your request and make it known to all staff and the Management Committee.

Various parents also take photographs and use video cameras at special events, to record their own child's appearance at these occasions, we also sometimes have the press in to put a report and photograph in the local papers. If you have registered your refusal of permission, you will be contacted for your views prior to these events.

You also have the right to rescind this decision if you want your child to appear in any group activity photograph e.g. Christmas Nativity Play.
