- Quality of teaching, learning and assessment – Good
- Personal development, behaviour and welfare – Good
- Outcomes for pupils – Good
- Early Years provision - Good

We are very pleased with the outcome and want to take this opportunity to thank both the Headteacher, Pippa Bremner, and her predecessor, Margaret Priggs, for their strong leadership. We'd also like to thank staff for their commitment during this challenging time, and parents for their valued support. We look forward to continuing to build on the strong partnerships that have been established.

We were particularly thrilled that Ofsted inspectors recognised that your children are proud of their school. Inspectors noted that the school environment was calm and purposeful, and that pupils are keen to learn and appreciate the enthusiasm of their teachers. They added that pupils enjoyed their lessons and homework, spoke highly of teachers, and behaved with respect and care towards each other and staff.

We are mindful that there is more work to be done, of course, but it was very encouraging that the Ofsted development points raised in the report are already in the school's development plan this year and receiving attention.
